Bible Study On Forgiveness PDF

1. Matthew 6:14-15 - Forgive to be Forgiven

For if you forgive others their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you, but if you do not forgive others their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

2. Mark 11:25 - Forgiveness and Prayer

And whenever you stand praying, forgive, if you have anything against anyone, so that your Father also who is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.

3. Luke 6:37 - Judgment and Forgiveness

Judge not, and you will not be judged; condemn not, and you will not be condemned; forgive, and you will be forgiven.

4. Colossians 3:13 - Compassionate Forgiveness

Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.

5. Ephesians 4:32 - Kindness and Forgiveness

Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.

6. 1 John 1:9 - Confession and Forgiveness

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

7. Matthew 18:21-22 - Unlimited Forgiveness

Then Peter came up and said to him, 'Lord, how often will my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? As many as seven times?' Jesus said to him, 'I do not say to you seven times, but seventy-seven times.'

8. Luke 23:34 - Jesus' Forgiveness

And Jesus said, 'Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do.' And they cast lots to divide his garments.

9. Psalm 103:12 - Complete Forgiveness

As far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us.

10. Isaiah 1:18 - Transformative Forgiveness

Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red like crimson, they shall become like wool.

11. Micah 7:18-19 - Merciful Forgiveness

Who is a God like you, pardoning iniquity and passing over transgression for the remnant of his inheritance? He does not retain his anger forever, because he delights in steadfast love.

He will again have compassion on us; he will tread our iniquities underfoot. You will cast all our sins into the depths of the sea.

12. James 5:16 - Healing Through Forgiveness

Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.

13. 2 Corinthians 2:10-11 - Forgiveness Prevents Schemes

Anyone whom you forgive, I also forgive. Indeed, what I have forgiven, if I have forgiven anything, has been for your sake in the presence of Christ, so that we would not be outwitted by Satan; for we are not ignorant of his designs.

14. Matthew 5:23-24 - Reconciliation and Worship

So if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there before the altar and go. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.

15. Philemon 1:10-11 - Practical Forgiveness

I appeal to you for my child, Onesimus, whose father I became in my imprisonment. Formerly he was useless to you, but now he is indeed useful to you and to me.

16. Genesis 50:20 - Joseph's Forgiveness

As for you, you meant evil against me, but God meant it for good, to bring it about that many people should be kept alive, as they are today.

17. Psalm 147:3 - Healing the Brokenhearted

He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.

18. Proverbs 17:9 - Love and Forgiveness

Whoever covers an offense seeks love, but he who repeats a matter separates close friends.

19. Matthew 18:15 - Resolving Conflicts

If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault, between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have gained your brother.

20. Romans 12:19 - Vengeance and Forgiveness

Beloved, never avenge yourselves, but leave it to the wrath of God, for it is written, 'Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says the Lord.'

21. 1 Peter 4:8 - Love Covers Sins

Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins.

22. 2 Chronicles 7:14 - National Forgiveness

If my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

23. Matthew 6:12 - Forgive Us Our Debts

And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.

24. Luke 17:3-4 - Forgive if Repented

Pay attention to yourselves! If your brother sins, rebuke him, and if he repents, forgive him, and if he sins against you seven times in the day, and turns to you seven times, saying, 'I repent,' you must forgive him.

25. Acts 3:19 - Repentance and Forgiveness

Repent therefore, and turn again, that your sins may be blotted out.

26. Hebrews 8:12 - God's Mercy

For I will be merciful toward their iniquities, and I will remember their sins no more.

27. Isaiah 43:25 - God Blots Out Sins

I, I am he who blots out your transgressions for my own sake, and I will not remember your sins.

28. Psalm 86:5 - Abundant Forgiveness

For you, O Lord, are good and forgiving, abounding in steadfast love to all who call upon you.

29. Jeremiah 31:34 - Forgiveness Under the New Covenant

And no longer shall each one teach his neighbor and each his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest, declares the Lord. For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.

30. Proverbs 28:13 - Confession Leads to Mercy

Whoever conceals his transgressions will not prosper, but he who confesses and forsakes them will obtain mercy.

31. Ephesians 1:7 - Redemption Through Forgiveness

In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace.

32. Daniel 9:9 - God's Forgiving Nature

To the Lord our God belong mercy and forgiveness, for we have rebelled against him.

33. Nehemiah 9:17 - God's Readiness to Forgive

They refused to obey and were not mindful of the wonders that you performed among them, but they stiffened their neck and appointed a leader to return to their slavery in Egypt. But you are a God ready to forgive, gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love, and did not forsake them.
